**Re: Security Council Extends Arms, Travel Restrictions on Democratic Republic of Congo,
Unanimously Adopting Resolution 2528 (2020)**

Dear Registrant,

The Compliance Commission wishes to inform that the UN Security Council renewed the sanctions regime imposed on the Democratic Republic of the Congo for one year. Further, in renewing those provisions, the Council also reaffirmed a set of transport, travel and finance measures set out in resolution 2293 (2016), affirming that they apply to individuals and entities designated by the Security Council Committee concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
