NOTICE: The Compliance Commission's Electronic Registration Portal is open for Registration from Friday August 13th, 2021

The Compliance Commission (the Commission) is pleased to announce that the electronic registration portal will be open for registration from Friday August 13th, 2021. The deadline for Registrants to complete the online Registration form is August 31st, 2021. Penalties apply for failing to register online pursuant to the FTRA 2018 and The Commission's Administrative Penalty Regime.

Registrants must log on to the Commission's website, click on "Register" at the top or bottom of the homepage or under the Registration Tab then clicking on the 'Online Registration' Tab to register as either a Sole Proprietor or Company.

Registrants should note that a recovery email is a mandatory field for registration. In addition, registrants may select an approved agent to conduct a risk-based examination using the registration form once the select agent field is active. The Commission will issue a Notice to those Registrants who are selected for examination with the examination date prior to selecting an approved agent.
