**Re: Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee Removes
Seven Entries from Its Sanctions List- May 27th, 2026**

Dear Registrant,

The Compliance Commission wishes to inform that the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities removed seven entries from the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List.

Therefore, the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2734 (2024) and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, no longer apply to the seven individuals set out below.
